Construction of a day care home in Wolsztyn

Project description:

As part of the project, a building with two floors above ground, without a basement, with a flat roof surrounded by an attic with internal installations was constructed. The building was made in traditional brick technology with a built-up area of 518.01 m2, a usable area of 511.12 m2 and a volume of 2732.90 m3.

The project consisted of the following tasks:

- development of a feasibility study,
- construction works construction industry (including earthworks, foundations, storey walls, ceilings, roofs, floor covers and floors, window and door woodwork, plasters and internal cladding, facades and external elements, land development: earth leveling, footpaths fire protection road and access to the building, marking), sanitary industry (connections to the building, water and sewage systems, central heating, ventilation and air-conditioning systems, gas, gas boiler room) and electrical industry (connection to the building, installations indoor, outdoor lighting)
- equipment of the facility, including, among others, sports ladders, handrails for people with disabilities, kitchen tables, a gastronomic hood, a stainless steel wardrobe.

The constructed facility consists of rooms for the needs of a day care home for the elderly and partly (17.1% of the total usable area of the facility) administrative rooms of the Social Welfare Center in Wolsztyn.

The building includes e.g. such rooms as: a residence hall, an exercise room, a rest room, a nurse's room, social and sanitary rooms, administrative rooms. A recreation area for the users of the facility was created around the building.

This is the first such facility in the Wolsztyn Commune.
